## This funding will be used to

- Ensure 100% of student in Year 3 are achieving National Minimum Standards in 2015 or meeting the guaranteed standards of an evidenced based plan.
- Target early literacy and numeracy support to those students not achieving age or year appropriate benchmarks/standards and ensure they are working on an Individual Learning Guarantee (ILG) or an Individual Curriculum Plan (ICP).
- Increase the percentage of students in Year 5 from 72% to 85% achieving above NMS in 2015 or meeting the guaranteed standards of an evidenced based plan.
- Increase the percentage of students in Year 5 Upper 2 Bands (U2B) in NAPLAN writing and numeracy from 0% to 20% by 2015.

- Rapid Recall Routines across the whole school (Archer/Fleming)
- HOT Tasks Numeracy across the whole school (Proffitt-White/Sullivan)
